- ! Second Semester: from late-February to late-June

Application

Online student application period and deadlines

- ! First Semester Entry March 01 to 31
- ! Second Semester Entry September 01 to 30

Online coordinator confirmation period

- First Semester Entry April 01 to 10
- ! Second Semester Entry October 01 to 10

Qualification

- ! Both undergraduate and graduate students can apply.
- Students with only Taiwanese nationality are not eligible.

Length of the exchange period

- ! One academic year or one semester

Workload Requirements

- ! NTU requires at least 2 courses/credits per semester for exchange students. Besides, students should follow the requirements of their home universities.

In order to follow NTU courses taught in English or Chinese, students should have a level for English or Chinese Language Proficiency according to the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference). We trust our partner's selection, so it is not required to provide a language certificate.
